## Business Plan 2023/24: Mid-year update

The Sentencing Council's Business Plan includes a commitment to review the indicative timeline for preparation and publication of guidelines on a bi-annual basis and to publish updates as appropriate. While there are no major changes to the work plan, the timing of publication for some projects in this reporting year has changed.

Due to staffing resource pressures, some of the planned start dates for consultations later in the year have been pushed back by a few months and are expected now in early 2024. These are:

- new guidelines for blackmail, kidnap and false imprisonment
- revised guidelines on aggravated vehicle-taking and other motoring related matters
- new guidelines for immigration offences

Further projects have been added to the business plan since its original publication:

- a new guideline on non-fatal strangulation
- new guidelines for protest offences

The provisional timetable for other projects remains subject to change dependent on factors such as the available resources, unforeseen complexities, consequential delays from other projects and legislative changes. The revised indicative dates are included in the table below.

The Business Plan provided target dates for publication of research and evaluation findings. Some of these publications have been delayed due to reprioritising resource coupled with the addition of new projects which are i) reviewing the 2018 overarching domestic abuse guideline, and ii) commissioning a follow-up to the review of evidence on effectiveness of sentencing published by the Council in 2022. The Council is also in the process of finalising for publication the reports on the user experience of online guidelines.
